Experiential Reading Instruction and Horse Powered Reading Instruction both share the same foundation and strategies however Equine Assisted Learning provides an added impact which may not be available to all teachers, therefore participants will have a choice of assignment tracks in order to match their educational setting of either school classroom or EAL arena. Equine Assisted Learning track assignments will require access to horses and adherence to EAGALA standards.
